- sitting in a circle, each player has an object (pencil, cup, ball) in front of him/her
- while singing the song, each player picks UP the object on the 'upbeat' (anacrusis) then passes the object to the right so that it is placed in front of the next player on the downbeat (crusis).
- in the penultimate measure (triqui triqui), players do not leave the object in front of their neighbours on the downbeat, rather they move the object back in front of themselves, then pick it up again, and place it in front of their neighbour on the final measure.
