TRANSITION SONG:

This is a great way to have children 'line up' or get ready for another activity.

Start with children on the floor (sitting or lying down - (even more fun!!) - or in their seats.

Sing "Pop Up, Annie..." and Annie stands and becomes the first in line.

Teacher can continue with the whole class list - OR

Ask 'Annie' to create the line singing Pop-up for each name....

OR:

... have Annie sing the next Pop Up and then whoever she picks sings etc...

It is important to keep the beat of this little song steady...

Initially it make take four beats (as in the first line here) to have the next pop-up.

Elevate to 2 beats in between each pop-up.

Children will want to be able to do the whole class with no rests....

that can be quite difficult for younger kids - they won;t want to think that fast maybe, but it is a good week's end (or month's end) goal.

reinforces 'Sol'mi' pitch relationship.

reinforces concepts of beat, tempo, and rests.

encourages individual singing, predicting. Listening, and listing.
